Sixth Order of Business – Old business and proposals

- *Proposals from last month submitted by Jill and Dove have been withdrawn for the time being by their request/approval
- 1) Proposal to move Participation Station and Ranger HQ to center camp
 - Summary of current discussion from last month's PC call and from PONY:
 - No objections seem raised to moving Participation Station and Ranger HQ to center map; the move has been requested by coords from both departments
 - Exact placement of Participation Station and Ranger HQ is still under discussion, with a select few areas being proposed/considered

Seventh Order of Business – New business and proposals

- 1) Discussion item: What to do about hot ash dumping? Submitted by LilBit
 - Agenda Item: Burn Barrel/Ash Dump Etiquette and Guidelines:
 - Issue: Steady increase over past burns of Sunday/Monday poor burn barrel etiquette, leading to hot ash and half-burnt log dumps during Monday Exodus.
 - o DPW and Exodus have to increase efforts to maintain safety.
 - This past May, multiple members from Exodus, DPW, and Greeters all pitched in to continuously cool down the ash pile, but by midafternoon we still had a "smoking hot" ash dump and Fernando actually stepped in to extinguish it.
 - Question: Have the multiple mud burns lulled Pdf'ers into a false sense of security? I'd like to start a discussion about what we can do to start curbing this bad burn barrel/ash dump behavior, raise awareness of the "Wise campers stop their fires early on Sunday evening so their ashes are cold during Pack Out on Monday." rule under public safety in the GUD, hear from our fire safety experts

- with any suggestions for easier ways to tend to the ash dump (if there are any?).
- Also, this ties in to the discussion from the Afterburn call and last call regarding the bit of uneven firewood distribution that's been happening. If burners don't have their extra firewood to burn until sunrise on Monday, maybe the ash dump can stay cool, the gates can stay warm, and the artists will have plenty to create with?
- 2) Announcement Theme camps and/or individuals will be able to buy their own wood through our wood vendor starting with the fall 2015 burn. Jill will be taking the orders and organizing delivery to camp sites. They still haven't determined how payments will be made, if they'll go directly to the vendor, or if they'll go through the BOD. That should be established soon and Jill will let everyone know as soon as the decision is made. If anyone has any thoughts or issues with this, please let her know via the PONY.
