** If Participation Station is closed, email photos of both sides of your laminate to participation@playadelfuego.org at any time during or after the event up to the final deadline in Feb 2024. **



- · One ticket per qualifying volunteer.
- The Volunteer Reserve Ticket Program (VRTP) can be redeemed for Playa del Fuego (PDF) only; the ticket and/or volunteer hours performed at pdf are not transferable to constellation or any other Fire Pony Creative Society (FPCS) event.
- Volunteer is responsible for verifying the accuracy of their email address at time of program registration. This email address will be used for your registration and purchase of next year's reserved ticket.
- Reserved means set aside. Not discounted, not free reserved. The volunteer must participate in the specially
 designated reserve ticket sale prior to the next event to obtain their reserved ticket.
- Persons that are banned from FPCS events at any point are ineligible to participate in the VRTP or redeem a previously earned reserve ticket.

THE BASICS

WHAT IS PLAYA DEL FUECO?

Playa del Fuego is a sanctioned Regional Burning Man Event in Tamaqua, PA. The event takes place on Memorial Day weekend in Tamaqua, PA, with its sister event Constellation taking place on Indigenous Peoples Day weekend. Both events are hosted by FirePony Creative Society.

Playa del Fuego, also known as PDF, is a Mid-Atlantic Regional Burning Man Event.

Playa del Fuego is an experiment in collaborative community building, featuring art, music, and a culture of play. This community is created by volunteers working together utilizing the Ten Principles of Burning Man as our guide. There are no spectators at Playa del Fuego; everyone collaborates in some way to create the event. It's a place for radical self-expression, acceptance, inclusivity, and respect.

THURSDAY: 5:00PM TO 12:00AM MIDNICHT Do not arrive before 5PM unless you are approved

- · Gate opens to new arrivals at 5PM.
- · Gate closes to all inbound traffic at midnight.

FRIDAY: 9:00AM TO 12:00AM MIDNICHT

- · Gate opens to new arrivals and re-entry passes at 9AM.
- · Gate closes to all inbound traffic at midnight.

SATURDAY: 9:00AM TO 8:00PM

- · Gate opens to new arrivals and re-entry passes at 9AM.
- · Gate closes to all traffic at 8PM for the pony burn.
- · No inbound traffic permitted except for re-entry passes.
- · Outbound traffic will resume once the fire team has given the OK.
- · Traffic will be restricted to emergency vehicles only during the pony burn.

SUNDAY: CLOSED / EXIT ONLY

- · No inbound traffic will be permitted on Sunday
- · Traffic will be restricted to emergency vehicles only during the temple burn.
- · Outbound traffic will resume once the fire team has given the OK

MONDAY: CLOSED / EXIT ONLY

- · No inbound traffic will be permitted.
- · All attendees MUST be out by 12PM.

Please note that all gate hours are firm and exceptions will not be granted.

WHEN YOU FIRST ARRIVE

WELCOME HOME! We know you are very excited but please stay in your car and have your IDs ready!

TICKETING 101

- · You MUST show up with a VALID GOVERNMENT-ISSUED LEGAL PHOTO ID that matches the info on the waiver you signed for your ticket.
- · If you have more than one adult ticket associated with your ticket account, you're doing it wrong.
- · No print outs or other forms of ticketing will be accepted at the gate.
- Please don't ruin others' experiences by pleading ignorance and jamming up the entry line.

A valid ID consists of:

- · A valid photo driver's license or valid photo identification card issued by the PA DoT or any other state
- · A valid Armed Forces ID card containing the holder's photograph
- A valid passport, passport card or travel visa containing the holder's photograph

Note: Playa Del Fuego strongly encourages all participants to practice Civic Responsibility by being up-to-date on COVID vaccinations, but will not be requiring proof of vaccination.

MINORS

All minors must be accompanied by a legal parent or guardian. Minors will need to have the waiver filled out by that legal guardian and the guardian's information documented onto the wristband. The Minor's waiver must be presented or filled out at gate BEFORE entering the event!

WRISTBANDS

Gate Volunteers will check your ID and retrieve your wristband. Participants must wear this wristband while on-site for the duration of the event. If a wristband breaks or is removed, it may be replaced by exchanging the broken band for a new one at the gate.

TEMPORARY UNLOADING

So that everyone gets a chance to come in and unload in a timely manner, participants are allowed no more than 30 minutes to unload their vehicle. If you leave your vehicle at your site longer than 30 minutes, you may be towed. Please only drive on marked roads, for everyone's safety! Once you unload your vehicle, return promptly to the parking lot.

PORTA POTTIES

NOTE: there is no onsite water, there are no showers, there are no flushing toilets

There are plenty of porta potties that get cleaned during the event. IF IT DOES NOT COME FROM THE **BODY, DO NOT PUT IT IN THE POTTY!**

Single ply TP is the only exception. No beer cans, no tampons, no baby wipes! Please bring small zip-lock bags for your wipes, pads, or tampons and take it with you as part of the Leave No Trace ethic.

Hand washing stations are also provided around the playa. Please do not use these stations for drinking water, dishwashing or bathing. WASH YO HANDS!

RE ENTRY PASSES

As PDF is a sincere experiment in temporary community, leaving during the event with plans to return is highly discouraged. Please be radically selfreliant and plan to not leave. Re-entry passes are required to re-enter the event once you have left.

Re-entry passes are \$20 PER CAR/PER TRIP, via credit/debit card from Jim at Camp Re-Charge. There will be NO CASH SALES ONSITE. Re-entry passes are only for use Thursday -Saturday. Sunday is exit only.

In the event of a medical or other emergency, the need for passes may be waived on a case by case basis. See description of Camp Recharge for full details.

ICE

Ice will be available for sale prior to the burn on the PDF website (sales close the Monday before the event), and on-site during ice pick up times.

Ice Pick Up Times are Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 11:00 AM - 12:00 PM (Noon) and 5:00 PM - 6:00 PM at the ice truck near the lodge building.

Ice is \$3.00 per 7lb bag via credit/debit cards. There will be NO CASH SALES ONSITE.

LAMPLICHTERS

More than a public utility, the Lamplighters are a symbol of community, of participation, and a clear sign that the day has passed, and that evening magic will soon be upon us. Procession starts around 6:30pm every day to perform the ritual of lighting up our nights; and then gather together in the morning to take down the lamps and prep for the next evening. Lamplighters bring light to the darkness so the rest may party all night long!

Your Responsibilities

PARTICIPATE / VOLUNTEER

There are no spectators at PdF. You can participate in many ways, including volunteering, interacting, or sharing your art. Playa del Fuego is ENTIRELY run by volunteers. You are strongly encouraged to pick up some volunteer shifts during the event. Anyone can volunteer, even first-timers. Volunteering for six hours earns you a reserve ticket to the next PDF. See page 34 for info on the Reserve Ticket Program.

CONSENT

You are responsible for getting express enthusiastic consent before entering a camp, going in for a hug, touching a person or their things, taking a person's picture, or having sexual relations.

Consent is an affirmative, unambiguous, and conscious decision by each participant to engage in mutually agreed-upon activity. The consent has to be ongoing throughout any encounter, and enthusiastic consent is best!

EASY CONSENT CUIDE:

- NO means NO.
- NO means NO the first time, every time, and completely.
- No cajoling, no "c'mon please", no emotional blackmail. NO means NO!
- · YES means YES. Enthusiastic YES is best!
- SILENCE = NO. MAYBE = NO. NOT YET = NO.
- Only YES = YES.
- Consent IS binary! Consent can be revoked at any time, even if you have touched that person in that same way before. Consent can be revoked after saying YES. You do not have the right to touch anyone without an enthusiastic and ongoing YES! This goes for hugs, handshakes, sexual activity, and shiny costumes!

SELF RELIANCE

You are responsible for your basic needs (food, water, shelter), your safety, and your wellbeing the entire time of your stay at PdF. We call this Radical Self Reliance.

Stay Hydrated!

Dehydration is a very serious risk at PDF; **DRINK WATER**, **and lots of it**. Alcohol and caffeine dehydrate you; it is not water.

Staying Warm

Evenings can be cold in this part of PA. Please bring sufficient clothing and sleeping supplies to avoid possible hypothermia.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

Playa del Fuego is Regional Burning Man event. The 10 Principles of Burning Man quide our community.

10 PRINCIPLES OF BURNING MAN



Radical Inclusion

Anyone may be a part of Burning Man. We welcome and respect the stranger. No prerequisites exist for participation in our community.



Gifting

Burning Man is devoted to acts of gift giving. The value of a gift is unconditional. Gifting does not contemplate a return or an exchange for something of equal value.



Decommodification

In order to preserve the spirit of gifting, our community seeks to create social environments that are unmediated by commercial sponsorships, transactions, or advertising. We stand ready to protect our culture from such exploitation. We resist the substitution of consumption for participatory experience.



Radical Self-reliance

Burning Man encourages the individual to discover, exercise, and rely on his or her inner resources.



Radical Self-expression

Radical self-expression arises from the unique gifts of the individual. No one other than the individual or a collaborating group can determine its content. It is offered as a gift to others. In this spirit, the giver should respect the rights and liberties of the recipient.



Communal Effort

Our community values creative cooperation and collaboration. We strive to produce, promote, and protect social networks, public spaces, works of art, and methods of communication that support such interaction.



Civic Responsibility

We value civil society. Community members who organize events should assume responsibility for public welfare and endeavor to communicate civic responsibilities to participants. They must also assume responsibility for conducting events in accordance with local, state, and federal laws.



Leaving No Trace

Our community respects the environment. We are committed to leaving no physical trace of our activities wherever we gather. We clean up after ourselves and endeavor, whenever possible, to leave such places in a better state than when we found them.



Participation

Our community is committed to a radically participatory ethic. We believe that transformative change, whether in the individual or in society, can occur only through the medium of deeply personal participation. We achieve being through doing. Everyone is invited to work. Everyone is invited to play. We make the world real through actions that open the heart.



Immediacy

Immediate experience is, in many ways, the most important touchstone of value in our culture. We seek to overcome barriers that stand between us and a recognition of our inner selves, the reality of those around us, participation in society, and contact with a natural world exceeding human powers. No idea can substitute for this experience.

CONSENT-BASED CULTURE

Playa del Fuego promotes a consent-based culture. In the spirit of Civic Responsibility the PDF Planning Committee invited Assterix to help us teach and remind us all the principles of a consent-based culture that we are calling, "Don't be an Asshole".

MEET ASSTERIX THE "DON'T BE AN ASSHOLE" PONY

Are vou

being an

asshole?

Assterix is a Boundary Affirming Pony

You don't need to change your boundaries for someone.

Boundaries can be different for every person and in every moment.

It's OK if you haven't figured out where your boundaries are yet.

Are you dealing with an asshole?

You can be direct or indirect. Get help from a friend or call a Ranger for assistance.

Say "Stop" - You always have the right to say "stop", or "that is not okay."

Address the specific behavior that is harmful. Someone may not be aware of how they are acting.

See Something Happening? Here are some options.

Step In - Directly intervene in a situation. Speak up about the harm. Be firm and clear.

Interrupt either the person causing harm or the situation.

Take an indirect approach to de-escalate the situation. Distracting attention away from the person causing harm gives the person experiencing harm time to move away.

Here are some ways to stop being an asshole.

Ask a friend to be your asshole buddy. Listen when they tell you that you have or are about to cross a line.

If someone wants to talk to you about your behavior, and you listen, you are part of the solution, not part of the problem.

If someone wants to talk to you about your behavior, it's OK to feel defensive and still listen.


If substances are involved, you could be breaching someone's boundary even if they verbally consent.

Body language alone can't say "Yes", but it can say "No".

You don't have to have all the answers. We're all learning together.

Just because it's ok now doesn't mean it's ok later.

If someone says "No", they might not feel like explaining themselves either. That's OK.



FIRE SAFETY

It is your responsibility to Burn All the Things safely! Tent fires and fuel fires are a real threat.

At a minimum, every burner should be aware of the following safety rules:

- All Fire Pits / Campfires / Burn Barrels must be attended at all time and kept 6 inches off the ground to prevent burn scars (burn scars are a trace!)
- All Fires and Generators must have (minimum) a 5 lb.
 ABC Fire extinguisher & 5 gallons of water on hand
- Fuel storage areas must have a "No Smoking" sign
- There should be a 15 ft min clearance from any tents
- No fire source should be under any canopy/structure
- No Fire Spinning without a safety
- No Fire Spinning near combustibles
- All liquid fuels must be maintained at a minimum of 30 ft from any fire, ignition, or radiant heat.
- · Generators must properly baffled for sound

LEAVE NO TRACE / MOOP

Practicing a Leave No Trace Ethic is simple: leave the place you visit the same or better than you found it; leave no trace of your having been there. $MOOP = \underline{M}ATTER \ \underline{O}UT \ \underline{O}F \ \underline{P}LACE. \ At \ all \ times \ on \ the site, you \ are responsible for the trash you create.$

No Public Trash Cans, No Dumpsters, Pack It In - Pack It Out!

LEAVE NO TRACE TIPS:

- Do a MOOP sweep of your camp all weekend long, and a final MOOP sweep before you go.
- Do Not Use the Playa as Your Toilet Porta Potties are provided. Porta Potties are NOT trash cans; take your beer cans with you!
- Add a ziplock type bag to your pocket or bag to collect trash you find as you wander.
- Be Aware of Very Small Items Be conscious of spare nails, cigarette butts, peanut shells, etc.
- Do NOT pour leftover fuel or genny gas on the Plava!
- Minimize Fire Impacts Avoid creating a burn scar by using a raised fire pit, or use fire shields to protect the ground.
- If you have uncrushable bottles, you can stuff other smaller trash inside them, minimizing the volume of trash you will need to haul out.
- Pockets, Bags, and Carabiners are great! When you visit a camp, take your trash with you.

INTRODUCING THE NEW MOOP PROJECT!

Participate in The MOOP Project to collect MOOP data at PDF this year! This project relies on a burner made app to collect the data. Scan QR code to get started. Everyone is welcomed to help out, not just LNT volunteers. Data will be used to create a MOOP map, educational materials, and organize MOOP and found items.

CRAY WATER MANAGEMENT

The Tamaqua site has no water. You are responsible for bringing enough water for the duration of the event and for packing out the water you can't disperse when you leave.

What is Gray Water? Water that has been used for cooking, washing, dishwashing, or bathing and contains soap, detergent, food scraps, or food residue.

Disperse: Small amounts of "light" gray water such as shower water that used biodegradable soap can be sprinkled around on the ground so as not to make a puddle. For dishwater that used biodegradable soap, best practice is to use a fine strainer to remove fine food particulates and add a drop of bleach to sanitize before sprinkling about.

Pack out: All other gray water and greasy messes must be packed out!

RULES

CODE OF CONDUCT

FirePony Creative Society (FPCS or FirePony) strives to keep the number of rules to a minimum, however certain types of behavior serve only to harm other participants, the event itself, and/or the community. Radical inclusion means that strangers are welcome to participate in our community; it does not mean tolerance of harmful behaviors.

The Code of Conduct identifies behaviors and actions that will not be tolerated at any FPCS sponsored event, including Playa del Fuego (PDF), Constellation, the Mid-Atlantic Leadership Conference (MALC), and recipients of grant funds through the Community Art and Civic Engagement (CACE) program.

INCIDENT REPORTING

Participants may report any incident in which another participant engaged in any Prohibited Behavior as detailed in the Code of Conduct. The FirePony Creative Society Conduct Committee may consider investigating incidents that occurred outside a FPCS sponsored events such as Protective Orders, racist activity and Hate Speech, patterns of abusive behavior like stalking or harassment, history of prior misconduct, criminal charges, and/or violations of the Code of conduct or similar policies at other events.

In addition to the conduct detailed below, participants of any FirePony Creative Society-sponsored events are expected to comply with all federal, state, and local laws.

The FPCS Conduct Committee is the mechanism by which reported conduct incidents are investigated.

PROHIBITED BEHAVIORS

The following types of behavior are unacceptable at FirePony Creative Society-sponsored events, including, but not limited to, Playa del Fuego and Constellation, and may result in a Conduct Committee Review:

CONSENT VIOLATIONS

Non-consensual and unwanted contact with the body of another, especially of an aggressive or sexual nature, regardless of claimed intent. Unwanted sexual attention, including sexualized comments or jokes. Non-consensual intoxication (includes gifting intoxicants without disclosure and putting a drug into someone's drink without their knowledge). Also includes non-consensual demeaning speech, predatory behavior, and aggression, as well as doxxing, blackmail, and the taking of photographs or video without the express consent of those involved (see "Media Without Consent" below). FPCS supports body autonomy for all participants and direct and unambiguous enthusiastic consent is expected of all participants at all times.

HATE SPEECH

Any conduct, depiction, video, image, audio, gesture, symbol, art, item, and/or discussion ("content") that consists of abuse, threats, intimidation, animosity, attacks, or incitement of attacks against an individual or group of people and is defined in terms of race, ethnicity, national origin, gender expression, religion, sexual orientation, immigration status, disability, health status, economic status, location, or any identifying characteristic. Hate Speech includes slurs and any content that incites the hatred or violence against these groups as well as praise and/ or glorification of terrorism, organized crime, hate groups, and/or dangerous indivudals or groups, including any/all Nazi and White Power content. symbolism, items, or expression (including the Confederate flag).

Hate Speech that is shared in an educational, historical, satirical, or artistic manner with the spirit of challenging it or raising awareness is allowed; however the intention surrounding that content must be clearly evident and the participant must be willing to engage in respectful discussion with the community about their content.

BULLYING, INCLUDING STALKING AND HARASSMENT

Any conduct that intimidates, abuses, menaces, or threatens participants and/or has the intention to exclude, silence, shame, or degrade a participant (or group), or incites others to do so. Includes all manner of stalking and harassment, including conduct such as intimidation, verbal assaults, threats of violence or harm, degrading or shaming speech, humiliation, and repeated unwanted contact, both in person and electronic.

ENDANCERING OTHERS

Any conduct or content that puts others in serious danger, including personal attacks and violence, unsafe operation of any vehicle (includes your personal vehicle, golf cart, art car, and bicycle), unauthorized fireworks, unsafe flame art and/or burning art, not maintaining general fire safety protocols (such as spinning fire without a designated safety or improper storage of fuels), and/or violations of any safety and fire policies provided by a FPCS sponsored event.

ENTERING A FPCS SPONSORED EVENT WITHOUT A TICKET OR SERVICE CONTRACT

All participants, volunteers, coordinators, board members, landowners, etc. gain entry to our events by purchasing a ticket, signing the Code of Conduct, and presenting a valid ID at the gate. Vendors, such as ice delivery or the porta potty cleaners, are under contract with FirePony Creative Society and are allowed on site to fulfill their contracts. Any other entries are unauthorized and will be considered trespassing. Aiding or helping an unauthorized entry get into a FPCS sponsored event will also be considered trespassing and will subject that participant to repercussions.

DESTRUCTION, USING, OR TAKING OF PROPERTY

Includes theft, destruction, and vandalism of any property, including FPCS infrastructure as well as landowner, vendor or participant property. Consent applies to things as well as bodies. If it is not yours, leave it alone, unless you have the consent of the owner of the property.

MEDIA WITHOUT CONSENT

Direct and unambiguous consent is required before photographing or recording any participant at a FPCS event. Direct and unambiguous consent is also required when sharing any video, photograph, or content depicting a participant taken at a FPCS sponsored event on social media. Absolutely no media, content, video, image, description, or depiction of a FPCS event may be used for commercial purposes without prior written consent of the FPCS Board of Directors.

Transgressions that violate federal, state, or local laws will be escalated to the appropriate authority.

Try to make that coexistence a peaceful one. Abide by all relevant local, state, and federal laws. If you see law enforcement officers, be nice to them. PDF will cooperate with all local, county, state, and federal officials. We all share an interest in having a smooth event.

DRINKING AND DRIVING

Don't be stupid, motorized vehicles don't mix with intoxication. Any ticket holder found driving while intoxicated/under the influence may be ejected from the event. This includes cars, RVs, buses, electric bicycles, art cars, tractors, golf carts, motorized scooters, and similar devices.

OFF LIMIT AREAS

All permanent buildings (hunting lodge and garage and any pre-existing structures are completely off limits to all participants well as any area marked within the event map as being off limits. Any area outside the event boundary, as marked on the event map, is strictly off limits. Crossing the event boundaries is TRESSPASSING on private property! Trespassing on the land outside the event boundaries is cause for event eviction.

Within the event boundaries, the following are **STRICTLY OFF-LIMITS**:

- the red cabin, including its exterior porches

- any large piles of lumber left on-site from logging

SOUND POLICY

- 10 AM to Midnight: 80 dB(A) @ 100 ft
- Midnight to 10 AM: 70 dB(A) @ 50 ft & subwoofers off



Amplified, projected or otherwise man-made noise or music shall be permitted between the hours of 10am and 12am. Beginning at 12:01am, all subwoofers (any device capable of emitting sound below 100HZ) shall be turned off and the sound shall be no louder than 70db(A) at a distance of 50' from the source of the sound, or at the Access Area boundary, if the boundary is closer than 50' to the source. Sound shall be no louder than 80db(A) at other times, when measured at 100' with a national commercially accepted Sound Level Meter or SLM. (Type S2A)

VENDING/CIFTING

Vending of any kind is not allowed. This includes promotion of other events. Gifting does not equal bartering, nor are you entitled to anything. It's only a gift when offered freely; taking something because you want it is still theft at PdF. Ask permission before taking or touching anything, or anyone.

PUBLIC MEALTH AND SAFETY

PdF is truly a community and we are here to help you navigate your burn! Amazing volunteers step up and put in long hours to help you when you need it most!

In the case of an emergency, locate any volunteer with a radio to call for a medic.

Medical issues beyond the scope of basic first aid could be triaged and escalated via ambulance to the nearest medical facility.

FIRST AID

Bandaids and other basic first aid supplies are available at Participation Station. Try to be self reliant and bring a first aid kit to take care of your own minor issues.

RANCERS

PdF is truly a community and we are here to help you navigate your burn! Amazing volunteers step up and put in long hours to help you when you need it most! Rangers are not cops and they are not your mom, but they wear a lot of khaki! They are here to help you resolve conflict via the FLAME method and document conduct issues. FLAME: Find Out, Listen, Analyze, Mediate, Explain. In times of need, RANGERS are your friend! Simply look for someone with a radio (they can call one) or if no one is around, just start calling loudly for a RANGER, and someone will hear you and respond.

Interested in becoming a Ranger? Or have Medical Certification (EMT or above)? If so, come by Ranger Station on Friday night at 7 pm for Ranger/Medic Orientation.

SANCTUARY

Sanctuary provides a positive space for those experiencing mental, emotional, or spiritual distress. Not feeling well, but it's not a medical issue? Triggered? Anxious? Simply overwhelmed at all the stimuli and need a quiet space? Sanctuary is here for you, gentle burner. You are safe here.

Playa del Fuego embraces Open Fire and Flame Effects, which means we must act in a safe and responsible manner. The reality of a tent fire or a more serious situation arising from its misuse is a threat to the future of our event and participant safety.

FIREWOOD

Firewood is included in your ticket price, and you are welcome to have a fire in your camp in a fire pit or burn barrel, as long as there isn't an active fire ban.

UN-USED FIREWOOD MUST BE RETURNED TO THE MAIN PILE on Monday. This is a Leave No Trace event! Extra firewood is MOOP. Put it where it belongs!

OPEN FIRE AND FLAME EFFECTS

All fires, regardless of the fuel, must be:

- Attended at all times
- Extinguished immediately at the request of any member of the Fire Safety Team or a Ranger
- Extinguished immediately if the wind picks up such that the fire throws sparks
- Maintain a safety perimeter of one and a half times the height of the flame effect
- Have 5 gallons of water or 5 lb. ABC Fire Extinguisher, or both, as appropriate for fuel type
- All liquid fuels must be maintained at a minimum of 30 ft from any fire, ignition, or radiant heat.
- All fires are to have a burn shield or be elevated minimum 6 inches to avoid burn scars.
- Fuel storage areas must have a "No Smoking" sign posted

FIRE SPINNING

Fire Spinners must have an accompanying safety. No exceptions! Safety must have fire blanket/duvet and extinguisher, either a double can or locking container dump system. No Fire Spinning near combustibles. Maintain a safety perimeter for spinners and audience.

FLAME EFFECTS AND PROPANE FLAMES

- Flame Effects must be approved for use onsite by the Fire Safety team.
- Flame Effects must be constructed in such a way as to meet or exceed applicable laws, codes, and industry standards.
- All Flame Effects and propane powered art must have a 1/4-turn shut-off valve that is exposed, visible at all times, and CLEARLY MARKED as the Emergency Fuel Shut Off and must inhibit ALL fuel flow to the flame effect, regardless of how many gas cylinders are connected to the flame effect.

FIREWORKS

Pyrotechnics and fireworks are defined as a device or assembly of materials containing gunpowder, explosives, or any other combustible substances that explode when ignited.

- All pyrotechnics and fireworks must be preregistered and approved by the Burning Art Safety Team – no exceptions!
- Use of unapproved pyrotechnics and fireworks, or use of approved pyrotechnics and fireworks in an unapproved manner, may result in event ejection

CENERATOR POLICY

If you bring your own generator you have an obligation to ensure that it's used in a safe manner and are trained in it's safe fueling and operation.

Attended at all times:

- Extinguished immediately at the request of any member of the Fire Safety Team or a Ranger
- Have a 5 lb. ABC Fire Extinguisher
- Fuel must be maintained at a minimum of 30 ft from any fire, ignition, or radiant heat
- Fuel storage areas must have a "No Smoking" sign posted
- Generators must be completely shut down prior to beginning refueling
- Loud generators are to be properly baffled with fire retardant materials
- No generators in areas marked "quiet camping" on the site map

A BRIEF HISTORY OF POF

PDF began with about 20 East coast residents who were preparing to make their first journey to Burning Man in the Nevada desert, and wanted to get together a little closer to home to celebrate the spirit of the event. They joined together on the beach of Assateague Island on Maryland's coast on August 1st, 1998. In the spring of 2001, Playa Del Fuego had grown so much that a new site was needed to accommodate all the participants and it moved to Flemings Landing, DE. In 2018, Playa del Fuego found a new home in Tamaqua, PA where it remains today. PDF is a 100% volunteerrun event, with volunteers administering art grants, managing parking, facilitating workshops, handling ticket sales, and so much more.

WHY IS THE EFFIGY A PONY?

Assateague Island, where PDF first began, is home to Chincoteague ponies (or Assateague horses) that freely roam on the island. While phenotypically horse-like, they are commonly called "ponies". This is due in part to their smaller stature, created by the poor habitat on Assateague Island. Assateague's horses are beautiful, tough, and wild. They have learned to survive in a harsh environment. There are few places in the United States where you can view wild horses. Due to their complex social structure the Assateague horses display a wide range of unique behaviors. With careful

management, the wild horses will continue to thrive on Assateague Island and provide enjoyment to thousands of nature enthusiasts, photographers, and people who just love horses! You can learn more here: nps.gov/asis/learn/nature/horses.htm

NAME CONTACT INFO

BE PREPARED FOR WEATHER EXTREMES

Our event is held rain or shine. It has been held during Nor'Easters, severe thunderstorms, coastal flooding, plagues of insects, and record heat and cold. A shade or rain structure can be helpful and shared with neighbors. Be sure to properly stake or rebar any structures you erect. Tents have blown away and out of the event grounds, becoming MOOP. Shade structures have become windborne and hit people in the head.

Stay Hydrated!

Dehydration is a very serious risk at PDF; **DRINK WATER**, **and lots of it**. Alcohol and caffeine dehydrate you; it is not water.

Staying Warm

Evenings can be cold in this part of PA. Please bring sufficient clothing and sleeping supplies to avoid possible hypothermia.

TICKS, WILDLIFE, AND LOCUST TREES OH, MY!

TICKS

It's possible there will be ticks in the area that carry Lyme Disease. All participants are encouraged to practice Radical Self Reliance and get educated on ticks and Lyme Disease before arriving at the event. Frequent tick checks and tick repellent are strongly suggested.

WILDLIFE

Local wildlife includes black bears, foxes, bobcats, coyotes, racoons, rattlesnakes, copperheads, and deer. Interaction with wildlife isn't expected as the noise of the event will likely keep wildlife away, however, if you encounter a black bear, identify yourself by speaking in a calm, appeasing tone and back away slowly, preferably in the direction you came. We strongly recommend wearing boots because both rattlesnakes and copperheads are venomous.

LOCUST TREES

They are present on the property and have big thorns, really BIG thorns. We strongly suggest wearing boots and making sure the area where you set up your tent is free from locust tree debris and stumps. Each year we try to remove more and more locust tree stumps so over time they are less and less of a problem; you can help by bringing a shovel or a small hatchet and taking the time to remove some.

MAYOR

PDF is a city and it has a Mayor! The Mayor is a member of the Board of Directors who makes themselves available to listen to community member's ideas, dreams, concerns, and complaints about PDF. The Mayor has been known to take bribes. You can, of course, talk to any board member throughout the weekend, but the Mayor is a board member who has made themselves conspicuous for your convenience. If you have any questions or concerns (or bribes), look for the Mayor.

This year's Mayor is Smiles!

Smiles (she/her) lost her burginity at PDF Spring 2011 and has been a loyal backfielder ever since. What is a Land Acknowledgement?

Acknowledgment is a simple, powerful way of showing respect and a step toward correcting the stories and practices that erase Indigenous people's history and culture. Acknowledgment by itself is a small gesture. It becomes meaningful when coupled with authentic relationships and informed action

Tamaqua has a rich indigenous history. The People of the Lenni Lenape Nation have been on this land well before any of our ancestors. We are a group of people who believe strongly in Civic Duty and leaving the land as we found it (LNT). We need to go beyond the confines of our events to be true to those words, because a Land Acknowledgement without genuine action is deeply performative.

Presently the people of Lenape Nation are in a battle with Pennsylvania for official recognition. Pennsylvania is 1 of 13 states to refuse recognition to any Native Indigenous People in the state. The Lenape Nation has an organization working on preserving the culture, educating their young people on the language, and they are continuing to fight for recognition. They had a rally outside the state capitol on May 1st, 2023 continuing their demands for federal recognition.
